- Survivors learn soft and hard skills for job training, job interests explored
- Trauma-informed care is common practice with entire TCHTF
- Victim fears decrease, and safety is ensured, self-blame is reduced
- Key industries are informed and trained in identification
- Information and data sharing increases with deeper understanding of HT issues.
